

There's an App for That



Wild Apricot, the company that hosts the TCSC website, has an app that you can get for your smart phone. It lets you view your profile with all of the contact information you have chosen to share with other ski club members; look up individual members; see upcoming events and register; and check which activities you signed up for.

To get the Wild Apricot App for Members, go to the Apple App store if you have an iPhone or Google Play store if you have an Android phone and search for Wild Apricot for Members.

Once you've downloaded and opened the app, enter your email address and TCSC Wild Apricot Password for access to the following menus at the bottom of your screen.

- **Members**: Displays all active TCSC members in alphabetical order. Type a member's name (first, last or partial) in the Search box to see the contact information the member has chosen to share. You can call or email them.
- Events: Displays the ski club's list of events and activities. By selecting an event and going to the Overview tab at the top of your screen, you will be able to see the name, date(s), registration and cost. You can register for events directly from the app and add it to your calendar. The Info tab takes you to the full description for the event. The Registrants tab shows you who else is registered.
- **My Tickets**: Provides a list of all events that you attended in the past and are signed up for in the future with a link to the event details.
- **My Profile**: Displays your TCSC membership information (address, email address, phone number, and interests), including your renewal due date. This is where you can edit your personal information.
